FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP

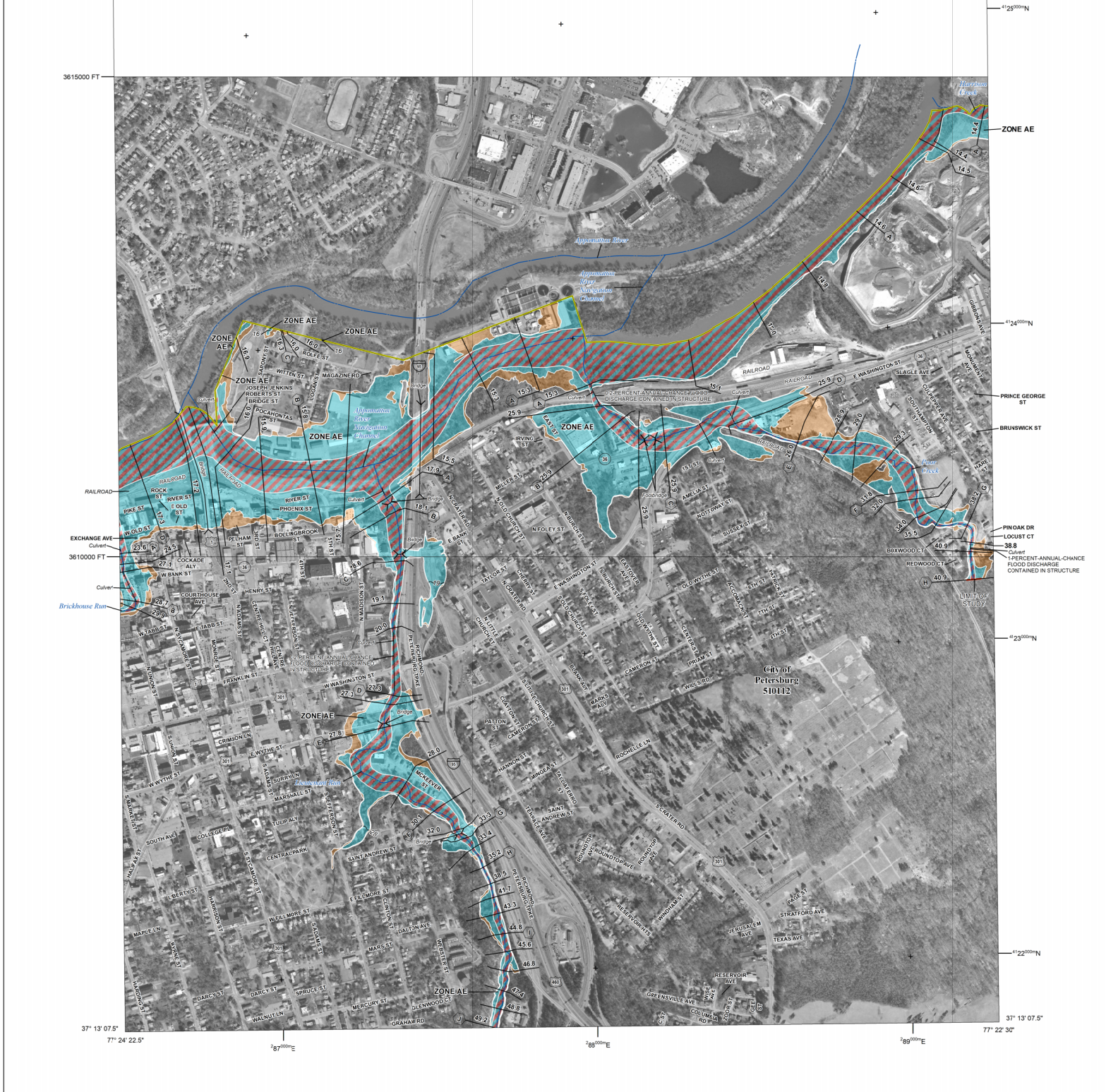
