DCR Survey Report 2/21/2022

Summary

This is a summary of a Department of Conservation and Recreation Services (DCR) survey that was administered by Virginia State University (VSU) Small Farm Outreach Program (SFOP). An Agreement established by DCR and VSU allowed for this project to be conducted. The goal of the survey is to evaluate the effectiveness of DCR programs, and to gather feedback from Socially Disadvantaged farmers (SDF) in Virginia, to determine the existing amount of SDF participation within the project area in either DCR or US Department of Agriculture conservation programs.

The survey was conducted during the period of November 1, 2021 and January 31, 2022. Participants were notified about the surveys by email, promoted on our Small Farm Resource Center home page, and delivered in-person by Program Assistants (PAs). A total of 218 participants provided feedback to the survey. Enclosed in this report are the findings and responses to the eight questions proposed via the survey instrument, and the Qualtrics survey report.

Q1. 25.60% of the respondents indicated "Yes", they applied for financial assistance for environmental conservation practices (i.e., Environmental Quality Incentives Program, Conservation Reserve Program, Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program, Conservation Stewardship Program, or others) through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) in the last three years, and 74.40% of respondents indicated "No", they have not applied. This indicates that most of the respondents did not apply for financial assistance for environmental conservation practices. Table 1 shows the number of respondents who responded "Yes" and "No" to Question 1.

Q2. 51.66% of respondents indicated that they intend to apply for an environmental conservation program(s) from the USDA in the future, and 48.34% indicated "No" to Q2. This indicates that almost half of the respondents to question 2 intend to and almost half of the respondent did not intend to apply for an environmental conservation program from USDA. Table 2 shows the number of respondents who responded "Yes" and "No" to Question 2.

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Q3. 14.69% respondents to Q3 indicated that they "have applied for agricultural best management practices cost-share program assistance through your local soil and water conservation district (SWCD) in the last three years, and 85.31% of the respondent indicated "No", they have not applied. This indicates that most of the respondents did not apply for agricultural best management practices cost-share program through local soil and water conservation district in the last three years. Table 3 shows the number of respondents who responded "Yes" and "No" to Question 3.

Q4. 37.88% of respondents indicated, "Yes, their application was successful", and 62.12% of respondents indicated "No", their application was not successful. This indicates that most of the respondents' applications were not successful. Table 4 shows the number of respondents who responded "Yes" and "No" to Question 4.

Q5. 46.63% of respondents indicated they intend to apply for agricultural best management practices cost-share program assistance through your local SWCD in the future, while 53.37% indicated No, they have not applied. This indicates that almost half of the respondents indicated yes, however most of the respondents indicated that they do not intend to apply for agricultural best management practices cost-share program assistance through your local SWCD in the future. Table 5 shows the number of respondents who responded "Yes" and "No" to Question 5.

Q6. 41.63% of respondents indicated they received technical assistance for nutrient management plans from the Virginia Department Conservation Recreation (DCR) staff, a Virginia Tech employee working with DCR, or a DCR contractor, while 58.37% indicated "No", they have not received technical assistance. This indicates that almost half of the respondents indicated yes, however most of the respondents indicated they did not receive technical assistance for nutrient management plans from DCR, Virginia Tech employee working with DCR, or a DCR contractor. Table 6 shows the number of respondents who responded "Yes" and "No" to Question 6.

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Q7A. On the question, "If you have not participated in agricultural best management practices cost-share program assistance through your local SWCD in the last three years, what was your primary reason?" respondents indicated the following:

- 36.46 % did not know about cost-share assistance through the local SWCD.
- 33.15% did not need cost-share assistance from the local SWCD.
- 13.26% have applied with the local SWCD before and found that my farm was not eligible for assistance due to its being less than 5 acres in size.
- 2.76% applied for cost-share at the local SWCD more than 3-years ago, but were not funded.
- 14.36% applied for assistance from either NRCS or FSA.

Q7B. The table below shows sixteen (16) respondents indicated that they applied for NRCS programs and six (6) of the respondents indicated they applied for FSA assistants.

Q8. There were ten written responses recorded for Question 8. The responses indicated that respondents did not have something positive to share about conservation programs. 26.50% of the respondents indicated "Yes" to "Is there any other information you would like to share about conservation programs" and 73.50% indicated "No".

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




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Q2. Do you intend to apply for an environmental conservation program(s) from the USDA in the future?


Q3. Have you applied for agricultural best management practices cost-share program assistance through your local soil and water conservation district (SWCD) in the last three years?






